

PRETEND SUNDAES

SCHOOL DAYCARE TECHNICAL SHEET



Materials:

- Corello+ Art paste (prepared according to instructions) 1130004 or 1140599
- Bowls 2037398
- Newsprint 1357706 , newspaper or kraft paper
- Masking tape 3391943
- Brush 855 series (optional)
- Tissue paper or Corello+ tempera paint
- Polymer varnish 120542
- Paper cups 1141233
- Model Magic white 1371095
- Corello+ washable markers 2300499 and/or color ink or tempera paint
- Aluminum foil
- Hard bristle brush (nail brush)
- Modeling clay tools 1238963
- Tongue depressors 1191600
- White glue 1131309
- color ink or tempera paint
- small plastic bags (to mix glue)
- Plastic lace 1510007, 1510015, 1510049, 1510056 (optional)
- Mungyo modeling clay 1370022

Steps

1. Shape newsprint (or recycled) paper into a ball .
2. Secure shape with masking tape.
3. Rip newsprint into small pieces.
4. Dip them one by one into the art paste mixture and glue them onto your structure (making sure to remove excess glue).
5. Spread art paste into paper with finger (a brush may also be used).
6. Overlap each piece of paper until your structure is fully covered.
7. Repeat to get a minimum of 3 coats (here you can alternate printed and blank page or kraft to distinguish each coat).
8. When finished the structure can be colored with tissue paper or painted (on fully dried). With tissue paper I recommend finishing with a coat of polymer varnish.
9. For Model Magic shape: Divide clay into number of colors you want.
10. Add color to model magic and mix in (with marker, ink or tempera).
11. Shape your creation. (An aluminum foil armature can be used for the center)
12. Leave to dry at least 24h.
