

Zen Indian Ink

Description of Technique

1. Cut a sheet of Manilla paper lengthwise in order to create a narrow format.
2. Place the Manilla paper vertically in front of you.
3. With a brush steeped in Indian ink, freely draw sinuous lines on the paper from bottom to top.
4. Using the brush, add a few branches and let dry.
5. With Donvale cardboard, make a stencil depicting a leaf or a flower.
6. Apply oil pastel over the solid part of the stencil.
7. Place the stencil over the Manilla paper and slide the colour inside the pattern with your finger.
8. Repeat these steps by moving the stencil wherever you want.
