

# Inspired by the Aboriginals of Australia

## Description of Technique

1. Choose a pattern that represents the culture of the Australian Aboriginals (kangaroo, turtle, snake, bird, hand or foot, character, fish, etc.).
2. Draw a pattern on brown or black paper and cut out.
3. Glue the pattern on brown or black paper or cardboard.
4. Fill the plastic bottle with liquid tempera to apply pointillism style. Use tempera markers for the continuous lines.
5. Work your way around the pattern by using both techniques in turn.
