Description of Technique

1. Start by assigning a geometrical shape to pairs of consecutive numbers on a die (1-2=circle, 3-4=square, etc.).
2. Assign a color to each number on the die (1=red, 2=yellow, 3=blue, etc.).
3. On a sheet of acetate, draw horizontal and vertical lines with a black permanent marker to make 6 squares.
4. Throw the die to determine the geometrical shapes you will draw in each square with the black marker.
5. Throw the die again to determine the color of each shape to be drawn using the color markers.
6. Throw the die again to determine the background color of each square. Fill in color with the appropriate marker.
7. For final assembly, glue the acetate onto a piece of crumpled aluminum paper and the whole work onto a piece of black construction paper.
