

Mandala

Description of Technique

1. Cut the back piece of cardboard into a square.
2. Draw two diagonal lines with a lead pencil to determine the centre of the square.
3. Cut a square from the stencil paper equivalent to a quarter of the black cardboard square.
4. Put the compass in the middle of the page and draw a circle inside the black square.
5. Without changing the radius of the compass, draw a quarter circle starting from one of the corners of the white square.
6. On the white square, draw a diagonal line in order to split the quarter circle in half and cut on the line.
7. Draw lines to subdivide the black circle into 8 parts by using the tips of the white cardboard.
8. Cut out shapes in one of the tips of the white cardboard to create a stencil.
9. Place the stencil over a part of the black circle and draw patterns with a colour pencil.
10. Flip and move the stencil into the next section and draw new patterns.
11. Repeat the rotation in each section of the circle.
12. You can make a second stencil with the other tip of the white cardboard to create new patterns.
13. Use colour pencils to decorate the mandala.
