

Paper and Cardboard Low Relief

Description of Technique

Preparation

For this activity, each participant needs a tray with a rim (a lid, the bottom of a box cut at 2.5 to 5 cm from bottom, or any other container with a rim).

Prepare 2.5 x 45 cm strips of construction paper (about 12 strips per person for an 18 x 25 cm tray).

1. Roll a strip of paper in order to make loops and/or a spiral.
2. To fasten it, glue the ends of a paper strip using a glue stick and insert a paper clip.
3. To fasten the patterns, you can also use a stapler.
4. While the glue dries, create other bows in the same way.
5. Place the rolled up strips inside the tray in a sufficient quantity to ensure stability.
6. Assemble the various elements to make a decorative mosaic.
