

Batik on Crumpled Paper

Description of Technique

1. On cartridge paper, draw a figure (outline) with wax crayons and colour the figure.
2. It is important to cover the entire surface of the page with the crayons.
3. Crumple the paper to form a ball.
4. Open carefully in order to not rip the drawing.
5. Using a paintbrush, apply an even coat of tempera over the entire drawing. The tempera will seep into chinks and create a batik effect.
